Cognitive Development

- Pre-number concepts:
Big/small, inside/outside, empty/ full, hot/cold, hard/soft
- Shapes: Revision of basic shapes circle, triangle, square and rectangle
- Number recognition, number sense and writing of numbers 1-10 in sequence
- Forward & backward counting of numbers 1-10
- Before, after, greater than, less than & equal to numbers (1-10)
- Associating quantity with numbers.
- Building problem solving skills through simple mazes and puzzles
- Number name- one, two, three
